CHILD CARE

California law does not allow excuse from jury duty because of child care. However, you may request a one time postponement up to 90 calendar days. ONE POSTPONEMENT PER YEAR. See AFFIDAVIT OF PROSPECTIVE JUROR.

SCHOOL

California law does not allow excuse from jury duty while attending classes. However, you may request a one time postponement. See AFFIDAVIT OF PROSPECTIVE JUROR.

DISCRIMINATION

California law reads in part: "No eligible person may be exempt from service as a trial juror by reason of occupation, race, color, religion, sex, national origin or economic status, or for any other reason".

LABOR CODE.....Section 230(a) of the labor code is as follows; This section provides in part that no employer may discharge or discriminate against an employee for taking time off to serve as required by law as a trial juror, if the employee prior to taking time off, gives reasonable notice to employer.
