## FORTIETH GENERAL ORDER RE: MADERA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT MITIGATION OF THE SPREAD OF THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

This general order serves as an amendment to this court's twenty-seventh and thirty-first general orders concerning applications for ex parte relief.

On June 18, 2021, the Superior Court of Madera County ("Court") issued its thirty-first general order, and contained therein, item number 11 continued the provisions of item number 7 from the twenty-seventh general order, issued on February 11, 2021, regarding this court's processing of applications of ex parte relief.

## EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, this court HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS:

1. That the items referenced above in the noted general orders are amended to read as follows:

Applications for ex parte relief shall be submitted pursuant to Madera County Superior Court, Local Rules, Division 2, Chapter 4, and notice shall be given pursuant to Sections 2.4.6, as well as Rules 3.1203 and 3.1204 of the California Rules of Court.

Any provision of the Thirty-First General Order not amended herein remains in effect.
