## ADDITIONAL FEE WAIVE PACKET-GUARDIANSHIPS/CONSERVATORSHIP

Use this Packet if you already have an initial fee waiver granted and you are requesting additional fees to be waived. For example; jury fees and expenses, court-appointed interpreter fees for witness, fees for a peace officer to testify in court or fees for court-appointed experts.

If your financial situation has not improved from your initial fee waiver you may qualify for these additional fees.

This packet includes the following forms: FW-002-GC Request to Waive Additional Court Fees (Ward or Conservatee) and FW-003 Order on Court Fee Waiver.


- Fill out a Request to Waive Additional Court Fees (Ward or Conservatee) (Form FW-002-GC) and the top of the Order on Court Fee Waiver (Form FW-003).
- 2. Turn in your forms to the clerk at the Civil Division (located on the 4<sup>th</sup> Floor). The clerk will tell you how long it will take to process your application for fee waiver.


If you have any questions you can ask the court's family law facilitator/self-help center (located on the 1<sup>st</sup> Floor) to review your paperwork.

## **Request to Waive Additional** FW-002-GC Court Fees (Superior Court) (Ward or Conservatee)

This form must be used by a guardian or conservator, or a petitioner for the appointment of a guardian or conservator, in the guardianship or conservatorship proceeding or in any other civil action in which the guardian or conservator represents the interest of the ward or conservatee as a plaintiff or defendant, to ask the court to waive additional court fees that are not covered in a current order. If you have not already received an order that waived or reduced your court fees, you must complete and file a Request to Waive Court Fees (Ward or Conservatee), form FW-001-GC, along
