2025 MISCELLANEOUS ORDER No. 6

IT IS ORDERED that effective January 2, 2025, cases in which the presiding judge within the Juvenile Division of the court¹ is disqualified shall be reassigned as follows:

- 1. All cases assigned to Department 36 in which the judicial officer is disqualified shall first be reassigned to Department 37.
- 2. If Department 37 is either disqualified or unavailable, then the case(s) shall be reassigned to Department 23.
- 3. If Department 23 is either disqualified or unavailable, then the case(s) shall be reassigned to Department 29.
- 4. If Department 29 is either disqualified or unavailable, then the case(s) shall be reassigned to Department 21.

If Department 36, Department 37, Department 23, Department 29, and Department 21 are disqualified or not available the matter shall be routed to the presiding judge of the Madera Superior Court (if not disqualified) or assistant presiding judge (if not disqualified) for further reassignment. If both the presiding judge of the Madera Superior Court and assistant presiding judge are disqualified, the case(s) shall be routed to the most senior judge² available who has not been disqualified for reassignment.
